Henson Scout Reservation:

Henson Scout Reservation-Camp Nanticoke is comprised of 1877 acres of pristine pinelands in Dorchester County on the Eastern Shore of Maryland.

Rodney Scout Reservation:

Rodney Scout Reservation is located on 900 acres of rolling woodlands at the head of the Chesapeake Bay, boasting over a mile of prime bay frontage. Rodney is located in Cecil County Maryland.
