Cub Scouts, Webelos, and their families are all welcome at camp! Cub Scouts and their parents can register either as part of their Pack, or as a family. Check with your Cubmaster or Pack Camping Coordinator to see if your Pack is coming to camp! Cub and Webelos Resident camp is an introduction to camping. It is not meant to be Boy Scout camping, but rather a shorter, less strenuous type of camping. A parent is encouraged to attend with their child.

The primary objective is to provide Cubs and Webelos, parents and other leaders with a meaningful, fun-filled experience, and to strengthen parent-child relationships.

What can you find at Cub and Webelos Resident Camp?

CAMP STAFF The camp is operated by a high quality, trained staff. All of our key area directors are trained and certified at BSA National Camping Schools.

MEALS are prepared in our camp kitchen and served family-style. Campers eat in our dining hall, where camp staff conducts a program after each meal.

CUSTOMIZABLE PROGRAMS Your Den or Family will be able to create your own schedule by choosing from a variety of awesome programs and rank specific Adventures. Programs will be directly related to the theme and will include activities such as fishing, boating, archery, BB shooting, and swimming! You can choose to focus on Advancement, FUN, or a little of both!

HEALTH LODGE A qualified first aider is on duty 24 hours a day, supervised by a licensed physician.

CAMPSITES Scouts and parents live together in a campsite with canvas tents and wooden floors. Each tent has two cots. Tents are arranged around a picnic table with a canvas roof. All campsites have a campfire ring, water and bathroom facilities.

BATHROOMS Modern comfort stations WITH FLUSH TOILETS are available for all Scouts and Adults. Each comfort station has 2 youth rooms, an adult male room and an adult female room with hot showers, toilets and sinks. Electricity is available in the adult rooms and each comfort station has a washer and dryer.
